Our school partnership model offers flexible curriculum and extra-curricular delivery designed to meet the needs of every setting.

Teacher CPD

Our qualified staff support teachers to grow in skill, confidence, and knowledge when delivering PE.

Through Premier League Primary Stars, we provide tailored, hands-on development that aligns with your school's curriculum and staff needs.

Social Action Projects

We empower pupils to create meaningful change in their communities.

Examples include:

- Broadacre Primary leading an environmental project
- Molescroft Primary developing a Pen Pals programme to tackle loneliness through intergenerational activities

Competitions

Inter-school events run throughout the year across regional and central venues, alongside school sports days and small in house competitions.

These events give pupils varied opportunities to represent their school.

To strengthen impact beyond the classroom, we deliver engaging workshops for parents and carers.

Sessions focus on supporting children's physical and emotional wellbeing, promoting active lifestyles at home, and reinforcing the positive values pupils learn in school.

Case Study – Jasper’s Journey with Tigers Trust & Premier League Primary Stars

Tigers Trust has a long-standing partnership with Sproatley Endowed CofE Academy, delivering Premier League Primary Stars across the school. Our sessions support pupils of all ages and needs through high-quality PE, targeted interventions, and positive role-modelling. One pupil who has made remarkable progress through our work is Jasper.

When we first met Jasper, he found it difficult to stay focused, follow instructions, and engage consistently. Baseline Premier League Foundation questionnaires highlighted low confidence and limited enjoyment of school.

To support him effectively, our staff worked closely with school colleagues, building routines, trust, and consistent expectations.

Morning PE sessions became a key intervention. They offered Jasper structure, routine, and opportunities to succeed early in the day. Activities were carefully adapted to develop listening, fundamental movement, and confidence, always ensuring he could participate fully alongside his classmates.

Jasper thrived on this supportive environment. When asked what he thought of the sessions, he said: “I love it, Mr Daddy is funny.” His enjoyment became central to his progress.

Across six weeks, Jasper showed significant improvements in confidence, independence, and engagement, both in PE and in the wider school day. His post-programme survey responses showed major shifts, including:

“I feel I am good at PE” – Yes, a lot

“Overall, I enjoy school” – Yes, a lot

He also received Star of the Week in our lessons twice, highlighting school-wide recognition of his progress.

Miss Reina, Jasper’s class teacher said: “Jasper has made so much progress. We are so proud of him.”

Jasper now arrives at sessions smiling, engaged, and proud of his achievements. His journey shows how fun, inclusive, relationship-led delivery can transform confidence, belonging, and enjoyment of school.



Our Impact – Highlighting the value of Educational Workshops

As part of the Premier League Primary Stars programme, Tigers Trust delivers a wide range of educational workshops that use the power of football, and the pride of the Hull City badge, to bring everyday learning to life for pupils across our partner schools.

These engaging sessions complement our high-quality curriculum PE, targeted interventions, extra-curricular clubs (including girls-only football), and projects for positive change.

Our workshops cover key themes that matter to schools, pupils, and communities. From Anti-Bullying and Children's Mental Health to Active Maths, World Book Day, and STARR assemblies (Sportsmanship, Teamwork, Attitude, Respect, Responsibility), each session is designed to develop confidence, character, and positive behaviours in every child we work with.

We also support whole-school development through teacher training, parent-facing workshops, and our ever-popular MKM Stadium Away Days.

What makes our delivery unique is how football becomes a powerful catalyst for learning. When pupils see their favourite club linked to topics like resilience, kindness, or problem-solving, messages become more memorable, relatable, and meaningful. This impact grows even stronger through our incredible player visits, which offer real role models who bring inspiration directly into the classroom.

Recent visits for Black History Month from Hull City's Pharell Brown, Cody Drameh, Darko Gyabi, as well as now former Tiger Joel Ndala helped spark important conversations about heritage, identity, and aspiration. For World Book Day, John Lundstram and Regan Slater helped ignite pupils' love of reading, showing how literacy connects with sport, teamwork, and imagination.

Across all workshops, our aim is simple: to create positive, lasting learning experiences rooted in fun, inclusion, ambition, and connection. By working with Tigers Trust, schools gain a trusted partner who supports whole-child development, both on and off the pitch, and helps every young person believe that they can achieve their very best.
